St. Xavier's College, XRCVC -Viviana extension is happy to announce an **online workshop on the theme "Simply Reading Without Seeing"** under its Tech Roshni series – A step at bridging the digital divide for blind and low vision persons. **This Workshop is supported by the Dhun Pestonji Parakh Discretionary Trust.**

Over the last few sessions, we learned how to explore various reading applications on the computer. There are few applications which help to perform these tasks with the assistance of Android phones. The Simply reading app is one of the program which allows us to log in to various libraries, download documents and gives the opportunity to read with the mobile device.

The Simply Reading app is simple to use by persons with blindness or low vision on a touch screen device and books can be directly downloaded and read in this app from any online platform such as Sugamya Pustakalaya and Bookshare. The application is free and developed by DAISY Forum of India (DFI) which aims to unlock digital reading for people who struggle with existing, more complex touch screen solutions.

In the upcoming workshop, we will study the Simply Reading program with hands-on experience.

Eligibility: participants should have good knowledge of Android phone gestures with talk back, touch typing and internet browsing.

Limited seats are available for the session.
