Google Drive is a file storage and synchronization package developed by Google. The service allows users to store data on their servers, synchronize data across devices, and share data. Users can Create files, edit through the office suite, and save them in Google Drive.

By default, every google Id users gets 15GB data free of cost and drive is a part of the each google account.

Benefits of Google Drive includes back up of data, opens edits several types of files across dissimilar platforms such as Mac/ Android/ IOS, Send Large Files to associates, Optical Character Recognition Feature, and many more.

Recent days drive has introduced a more flexible feature.

The workshop covers new basics features of uses of the drive with popular screen readers NVDA & JAWS.
