Extensive use of Android phones and G-mail has become an integral part of today's lifestyle. Many screen reader users are using basic HTML view while using G-mail, on the computer due to the simple web-based interface. Standard View provides an interface similar to that of other Google Workspace programs and can be functional using keyboard commands stated by Google. It also offers access to the entire range of Gmail features, while Basic HTML View is having limitations.

In the upcoming workshop, we will learn some basic features of G-mail in standard view with open source screen reader NVDA.

Eligibility: Participants should have good knowledge of Internet browsing, Fundamentals of G-mail, typing and screen reader.
