The application is free and developed by DAISY Consortium of India which aims to unlock digital reading for people who struggle with existing, more complex touch screen solutions.

In the upcoming workshop, we will study the Simply Reading program with hands-on experience.

**Eligibility**: participants should have good knowledge of Android phone gestures with talk back, touch typing and internet browsing.
