Did you know that Apple's iPhones or iPad come with a range of accessibility features, including support for external keyboards? In this session, we will explore how to effectively type using an external keyboard with VoiceOver.

Eligibility: Participants should have good knowledge of phone.

Criteria: Persons with print disabilities such as low vision (partial blind) or blindness.
