- Have you recently migrated to Windows 11 Operating System (OS)?
- As you are already well-tuned with Windows 10 and hence are finding it difficult use Windows 11 OS
- Are you finding difficult to configure/set your Windows 11 device from its settings?
- Did you know Microsoft will end support for Windows 10 on October 14, 2025?

Microsoft launched Windows 11 in 2021 as the next client operating system. Windows 11 is built on the same footing as Windows 10. If you are familiar with Windows 10, then Windows 11 is a natural transition. And therefore, XRCVC is happy to educate you on a few important settings of Windows 11 by conducting a Tech Roshni workshop!

Windows 11 on user feedback introduces a New Interface design for Start Menu, File Explorer, and System settings and also the removal of "live tiles." It also offers a faster, more secure experience, improved hardware and software compatibility, and several other enhancements.
