The Windows Phone Link application offers a practical solution. The XRCVC is organising a workshop focused on the Phone Link app, a Windows system utility designed to seamlessly connect your smartphone with your computer. This integration allows you to manage phone calls, SMS, and notifications from your smartphone via your computer interface.

During this one-hour session, participants will gain insight into the functionality of the Phone Link app, including an exploration of its accessibility features when used with the NVDA screen reader.
